

## FARMSTEAD OILING POLICY

### PART ONE – GENERAL

- 1) At the request of a resident and at the discretion of the Municipal Superior (or his designate), dust control will be provided by County forces.
- 2) The resident will be responsible for ensuring that the dust control is applied in the proper place and length, either by placing flags or being available when the equipment arrives.
- 3) The resident requesting dust control has the following options:
  - a) The resident requesting the dust control will pay a flat rate of:
    - ▶ \$1,885.00 towards 150 metres of oil per farmstead
    - ▶ \$2,500.00 towards 200 metres of oil per farmstead up to a maximum of 200 metres.

The farmstead oil will be guaranteed for a 3 year period starting from the date it is applied. Following the 3 year period, at the Supervisor's discretion, the dust control will be ripped up by Public Works Staff if it is deemed to be a hazard.

- b) The resident requesting the dust control will pay a flat rate of:
  - ▶ \$600.00 towards 150 metres of Calcium Chloride per farmstead.
  - ▶ \$800.00 towards 200 metres of Calcium Chloride to a maximum of 200 metres.

Calcium Chloride is guaranteed for one season.

- 4) Any request for dust control over 200 metres will be billed at 100% of the actual cost to the resident.
- 5) Dust control may be provided to residents who are adversely affected by a County gravel haul at the Municipal Supervisor's discretion. The maximum length will be 200 metres.
- 6) Dust control may consist of using water if the gravel haul is of a short duration.

### PART TWO – HAUL ROUTES

Any resident living along side of a designated haul route can receive dust control at his/her request.

Page Two

The cost of dust control will be NIL if the Municipal Supervisor and Councillor for the area agrees that the resident is adversely affected.

The County may supply and apply the most appropriate form of dust control up to a maximum of 200 metres (no charge).

Any request for dust control over 200 metres will be billed at 100% of the actual cost to the resident.

***DESIGNATED HAUL ROUTES:***

- 1) Nemiscam Road - From Highway No. 3 to Highway No. 61
- 2) Bow Island Shop Road - From Highway No. 3 going south for 12 miles
- 3) Bow Island Airport Road - From Highway No. 3 north of 4 miles
- 4) South of Skiff - From Highway No. 61 going south for 4 miles and 1 mile west to Highway No. 877
- 5) West of Skiff - From Junction 877 and Highway No. 61 west for 4 miles to the County Boundary
- 6) West of Etzikom - From Highway No. 61 going south to Highway 501

As traffic patterns change, the designated haul route list may also change.
