RESOL. NO. 1201/94

MOVED approval of the following Road Approach Policy:

1. Upon request, the County will provide one approach per half mile. The approach will be incorporated into the Road Program, if possible, when the Construction Crew is in the area. Additional approaches will be at the landowner's expense.
2. The approach will be to a standard of 30 feet wide with a 4 to 1 side slope.
3. The landowner will provide the material for the approach, if the landowner requests that the topsoil be removed and replaced, it will be at their expense.
4. Approaches shall not be installed closer than 40 meters to an intersection.
5. Landowners will move fences if necessary.
6. Site distances shall be considered when approaches are installed. e.g.: farm equipment should be easily visible to the driving public when entering the roadway.
7. If a culvert or extension is required, it will be installed at the landowner's expense.
8. The same guidelines apply to widening of approaches.
9. Moving of approaches shall be at the landowner's expense.

RESOL. NO. 543/96

MOVED the wording in Policy No. 180.5 - "Upon request, the County will provide one approach per half mile" be changed to: "Upon request, the County may provide one approach per half mile".

RESOL. NO. 322/2002

MOVED that the wording in Policy No. 180.5 Section 2 be amended to read, "*The approach will be to a standard of 40 feet wide (maximum) with a 4 + 1 side slope*".
