**VICTORIA DAY LONG WEEKEND
LIQUOR BAN POLICY**

Purpose:

The objective of this Policy is to implement a Liquor Ban at 40 Mile Park during the Victoria Day Long Weekend in order to discourage large parties from occurring at the Park. Many Provincial Parks and other recreation areas already implement similar liquor bans at this time, and this policy will bring 40 Mile Park in line with what is occurring in other jurisdictions.

Policy Statement:

A Liquor Ban shall be in effect at 40 Mile Park for every Victoria Day Long Weekend in the month of May from Noon on Thursday to 11:00 P. M. on Monday. The liquor ban prohibits the possession and consumption of liquor at all campsites, beaches, facilities and public areas within 40 Mile Park. In addition, all campsites will be by reservation only during this time, and the main gate will be closed from 11:00 P. M. to 7:00 A. M. to all members of the public except registered campers and season pass holders.

Any person witnessed in non-compliance with the liquor ban shall be asked to immediately vacate 40 Mile Park for a period of not less than 72 hours. All permits and fees will be immediately cancelled without refund. Failure to comply with the request to vacate shall result in the immediate contact of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police or County Peace Officer to perform an eviction.
