

DUST CONTROL PROGRAM

The County of Forty Mile No. 8 will be providing a *Residential Dust Control Program* in 2017. This Program allows for County Ratepayers to apply for a dust control material to be placed on a County roadway directly in front of their residence. The cost is shared between the County and the applicant for the first two hundred (200) metres purchased. Fees will vary based on the type of suppressant used and length of application.

In order to be eligible for this Program in 2017, a ratepayer must fill out an application at the Public Works Shop Office in Foremost, and provide payment for the service, prior to **May 1, 2017**. The Dust Control Policy is available for review on the County's website, www.40mile.ab.ca. The application form may be *printed* from the website as well.

SUBMISSIONS RECEIVED AFTER THE MAY 1ST DEADLINE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED UNDER THE 2017 DUST CONTROL PROGRAM.

The date of application of the dust control product will be at the discretion of the County's Municipal Supervisor.
