Contracting Out of Municipal Equipment:

Policy Statement:

The purpose of the Policy is to provide guidance to County Staff and to set out the conditions under which municipal equipment can be contracted to the private sector or agencies of other government.

Guidelines:

When not needed for municipal purposes, municipal equipment may be contracted to:

- The private sector on approval of Council.
- Agencies of other government and community groups on approval of the Municipal Supervisor with a report to the Chief Administrative Officer.
- Municipal equipment contracted out will only be operated by an operator approved by the municipality.

Contracting Rates wherever possible, - will be in accordance with the rates established from time to time by the Alberta Roadbuilders Heavy Construction Association (ARHCA). For equipment where such rates are not available, market value will be used as a guide.

Rates:

- Private Sector - 100% ARHCA Rates
- Agencies of other Governments and Ratepayers - 75% of ARHCA Rates
- Cemeteries, community halls, and churches will receive the service free upon request.

A Waiver of Liability will be provided by the private sector or government agency contractor which protects the municipality from all liability with the use of the equipment.
