Policy Statement:

The purpose of this Policy is to provide some guidelines permitting haying operations along road allowances or road side ditches.

Guidelines:

- 1) Requests are received at the County office by April 30th each year.
- 2) The party seeking to cut hay along a road allowance is the adjacent landowner or has received permission from the adjacent land owner that he is not interested in the hay.
- 3) That the person has entered into a Save Harmless Agreement with the County of Forty Mile No.8 with respect to chemical residue.
- 4) The County reserves the right to spray or treat prevalent weed patches within the County right of ways.
- 5) When baling of hay takes place that the bales will not be positioned as to restrict the lawful use of the roadway and shall be removed from the road allowance within two weeks of being baled.
- 6) The permit holder must carry out haying operations in a manner that no hazard to the motoring public will exist.
- 7) Applicant is responsible to post "Do Not Mow" signs (supplied by the County) in the area of haying.
- 8) All haying must be completed by July 15th of each year.
